

Odd & Even Sorting Cards

Pair the counters: even numbers pair up, odd numbers have one left over

Print on card stock and cut along the lines. For each number card, lay that many counters in two rows. If every counter has a partner, the number is EVEN. If one counter is left alone, the number is ODD. Sort the cards under the two heading cards below.

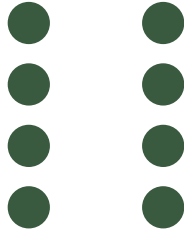
Cut out · two columns of dots show the pairs

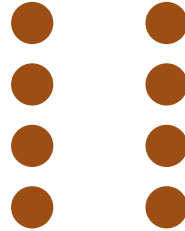

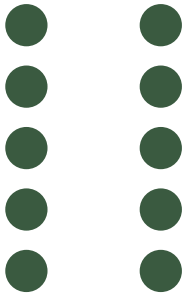
